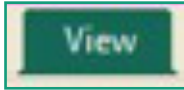
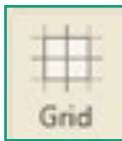


Draw a Continuous Line Design

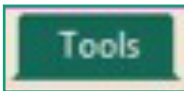
- Turn on the grid.
- Select the **View** tab.



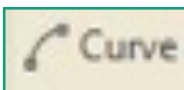
- Select the **Grid** button (it will turn green.)



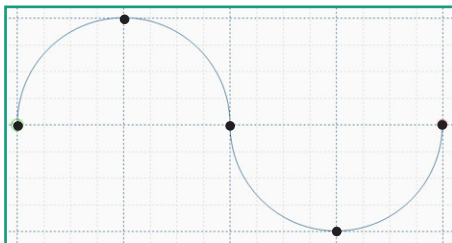
- Select the **Tools** tab.



- Choose the **Curve** tool.



- Following the diagram below, create 5 points to create the heart.

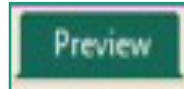


- After placing the last point, right click to finish the design.

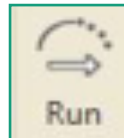
- After finishing the serpentine line, select the **Select** tool (click the heart to select it.)



- Add stitches by Selecting the **Preview** tab.



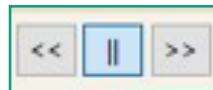
- Click the **Run** button.



- Click on the **Stitchout** button.

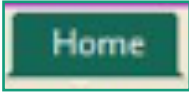


- Then click on the arrow keys to see how your design will Stitchout.

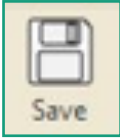


- Save your design.

- Select the **Home** tab.



- Click on **Save**.



- A window will open.
- Choose what folder you want to save in.
- Choose what File name to assign your design.
- The “Save As” type is default set to Inspiration Series (C2S). This is the artwork format.

Note: It is always a good idea to save in this file type first.

Save again in the file type for your quilting system.

- On your computer’s file manager, you can copy the file you just saved to an external USB, take it to your tablet, and stitch it out in Pro-Stitcher or other quilting software.
