

Note: This tutorial is for any size quilt, BUT the measurements are for a small quilt to be done in a class.

- Quilt size 15 x 16
- Select **File** tab.
- Press **Design**.



- Press **Open**.
- Select **1-PS Designs/Continuous Line/Clam Shell**.
- Press **Open**.



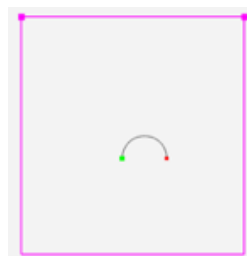
1. Create Area

- Select **Area** tab.



- Move machine to the top left corner of quilt top.
- Press **2 Corner**.
- Move machine to the right edge of the quilt.
- Press **2 Corner**.

- Since you are creating a 15" x 16" mini quilt, Type in the width of **15** and the height of **16** for the quilt.

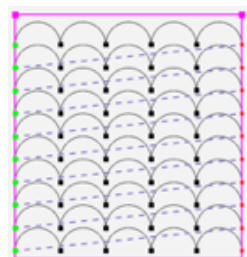


2. Repeat Design

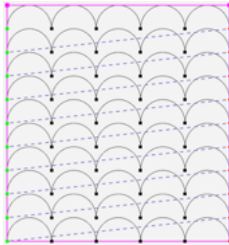
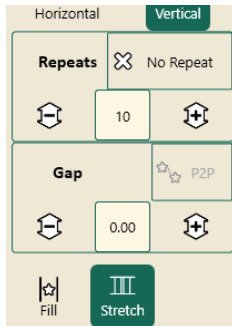
- Select **Repeat** tab.
- Press **Basic**.



- Press **Fill** in the sidebar on the right side of the screen.



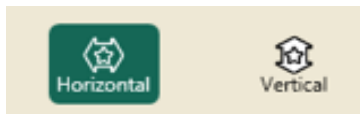
- Press **Vertical** in the sidebar.
- Press **Stretch**. This will stretch the rows of clamshells to fit the top and bottom of the area.



- Press **Wrap** in the Repeat tab.



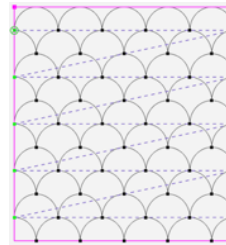
- Press **Horizontal** in the side-bar.



- Press $\frac{1}{2}$ button in Row.



- Every other row of clamshells will shift by half of the width of the design.



Press Baseline.

3. Quilt Design

- Select **Pro-Stitcher** tab.
- Press **Quilt**.



- Press **Run**. Verify Settings.
- Press **Proceed**.
