

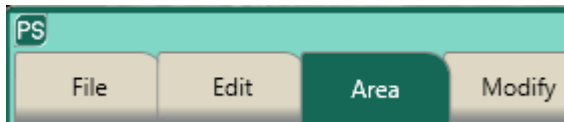
Follow these steps to crop areas inside an edge to edge design.

Set up your edge to edge design as desired.

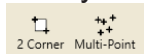
Baseline and Save. Clear current area.

Create Area.

- Select **Area** tab.



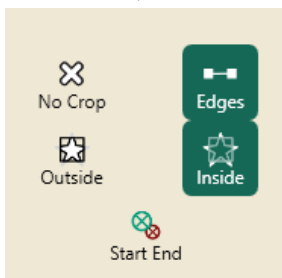
- Position your machine on the top left of the area you want to crop out. Press **Multi-Point**.



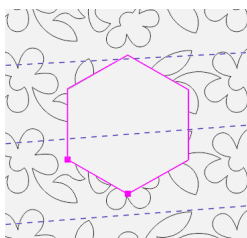
- Move the machine a few inches to the right, and press **Multi-Point** again. Continue across the top, move down the right side, back across the bottom, then back up the left side. Be precise with placing these points.

Crop Design.

- Select **Area** tab.
- Press **Crop**.
- In sidebar, select **Inside** and **Edges**.



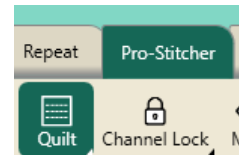
- **Baseline.**



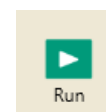
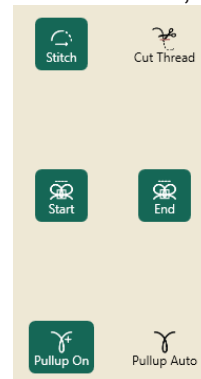
- Select **Area** tab.
 - Press **Clear** on the ribbon.
- Repeat as many times as needed across the throat space of your quilt.**

Stitch Design.

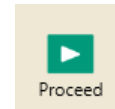
- Select **Pro-Stitcher** tab.



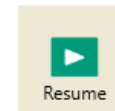
- Press **Quilt**.
- In the sidebar, select options.



- Press **Run**.
- Verify Settings window will load.
- Make sure your needle is up.



- Press **Proceed**.
- The machine will take one stitch and pause.
- Pull up your bobbin thread.
- Holding onto the bobbin and top thread,



press **Resume**.
