

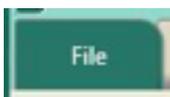
# Pro-Stitcher®

## Repositioning Design After Shutdown

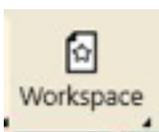
Move your machine so your needle is positioned where the start point of the next row is and drop your needle.

*Note: If the needle was dropped at the start point before shutting down, you do not need to move your machine.*

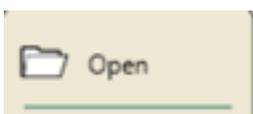
- Open your workspace.
- Select **File** tab.



- Press **Workspace**.



- Your saved workspace will be the first on the dropdown menu. Tap it once to open it.



- Tap **Baseline**.



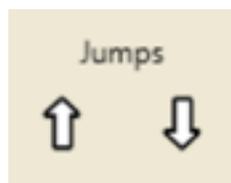
- Select **Pro-Stitcher** tab.



- Press **New Start & End**.



- There are two columns in the sidebar: Start and End.
- At the bottom of the start column, under the word Jumps, press the down arrow until the green start point is on the desired row.



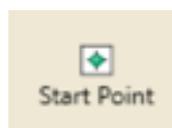
- Select **Modify** tab.



- Press **Reposition**.

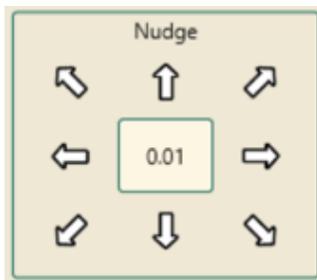


- Select **Start Point** from the sidebar.



**Note:** This will position the start point of the design with your crosshairs.

- To fine tune your design positioning, move your crosshairs (your machine) to the lowest point in the middle of the row already quilted and check alignment. Zoom in, then using the **Nudge** buttons if needed from the sidebar.



**Note:** If you are leaning on the poles of your frame when looking at the design it can change the alignment of the quilt.

- Move your start point to the beginning of the row you'd like to start quilting using Pro-Stitcher Tab <New Start End as instructed above. Once your start point is properly positioned, press



- Verify your tie-offs and pull-up options.
- Press **Run**.
